# **Boston Sightseeing - Sightseeing dates are approximate**

Beantown Trolley & Harbor Cruise: Board the trolley at any of its 11 stops and hop-on/hop-off or enjoy the complete 80-minute guided narration of the city. Stops include Faneuil Hall, Quincy Market, Copley Square, North End, USS Constitution - "Old Ironsides." From May to October, enjoy a 45-minute narrated cruise of Boston Harbor as part of the Beantown Trolley. During the off-season, view the Mapparium, a 3-story stained-glass globe, to gain a 3-D view of what we thought earth looked like in 1935.

Cambridge/Lexington/Concord: Journey back in time on the Battle Trail. Visit Harvard Yard and view Cambridge Common, drive along "Tory Row" past the home of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. Follow the route of Paul Revere. Stand on Lexington Green, where the Minutemen stood their ground against England's finest. In Concord, travel past the homes of Hawthorne, Alcott and Emerson.

Total Experience Narrated Tour: A combination of Cambride/Lexinghton/Concord and many of the Beantown Trolley stops.

Cape Cod Excursion: Ride by motorcoach across the Cape Cod Canal. In Hyannisport, visit a memorial dedicated to President John F. Kennedy. Join a narrated sightseeing harbor cruise that offers the best possible view of the Kennedy Compound. Travel the "King's Highway" through historic Sandwich. Stop for a glass blowing exhibit at the Sandwich Glass Museum and Gift Shop with additional free time to explore Sandwich.

Plimoth Plantation Tour: Travel to historic Plimoth Plantation where you will become part of the Pilgrim's 17th century world. In this living museum, accompany Pilgrims as they go about their daily tasks - talk with them, ask about their lives and what it was like to come to this foreign place and build their future. Objects from the museum's collection are displayed and an audio-visual presentation will give you a broad overview of 1620 Plimoth Plantation

New England Seacoast: Travel through Boston and its "North Shore" communities. Stop at Hampton Beach, NH. Continue along the coast of Maine, with a stop at the famous "Nubble Light" lighthouse in York. Head to Kennebunk Village and Kennebunkport. View former President Bush's summer home from Walker Point. Lunch and shopping in Kennebunkport on your own.

Fabulous Newport, Rhode Island: Tour Mrs. Vanderbilt's seventy-room summer home on 11 acres of ocean front land, The Breakers. Shop and lunch at Newport's beautifully restored waterfront. See glamorous private yachts, modern racing sailboats, Newport's fishing fleet and ships from around the world. In the afternoon, visit a second famous mansion, Marble House, built in 1892 with approximately 500,000 cubic feet of white marble. Enjoy spectacular views of mansions and secluded coves along the ten-mile Ocean Drive.

Autumn On Cape Cod: The Cape Cod Excursion (above) during September and October. Enjoy the beautiful fall foliage.

Fall Foliage Spectacular: Experience the New England countryside awash with the colors of an Indian Summer. Travel past quiet ponds and ancient farms, weathered roadside taverns and sturdy colonial churches. There will be several picture stops including an old fashioned covered bridge. Enjoy a delicious buffet lunch at the quaint Woodbound Inn in Rindge, NH. Afterwards, a pleasant afternoon of foliage display is capped off with a stop at a local farm stand for apples and cider.
